Play Dough

**3 cups water
3 cups flour
1 1/2 cup salt
6 tablespoons oil
6 teaspoons Cream of Tartar
Food Coloring**

Use and electric skillet or large saucepan. Mix well before the heat is turned on. Cook and stir over low heat until mixture sticks together in a ball and the color has dulled somewhat. Cool. Knead well. Stored in an air-tight container, play dough will keep for months.
