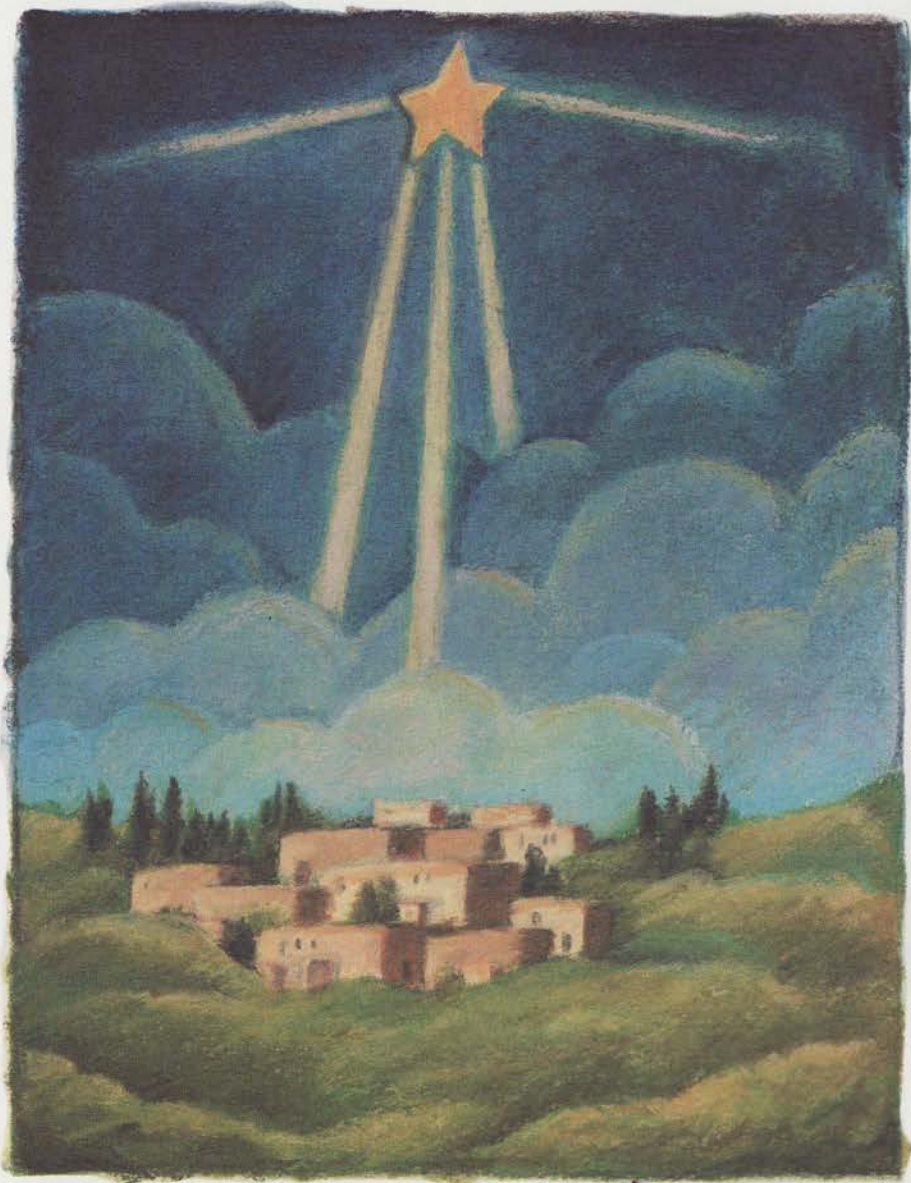




# LOVE ONE ANOTHER

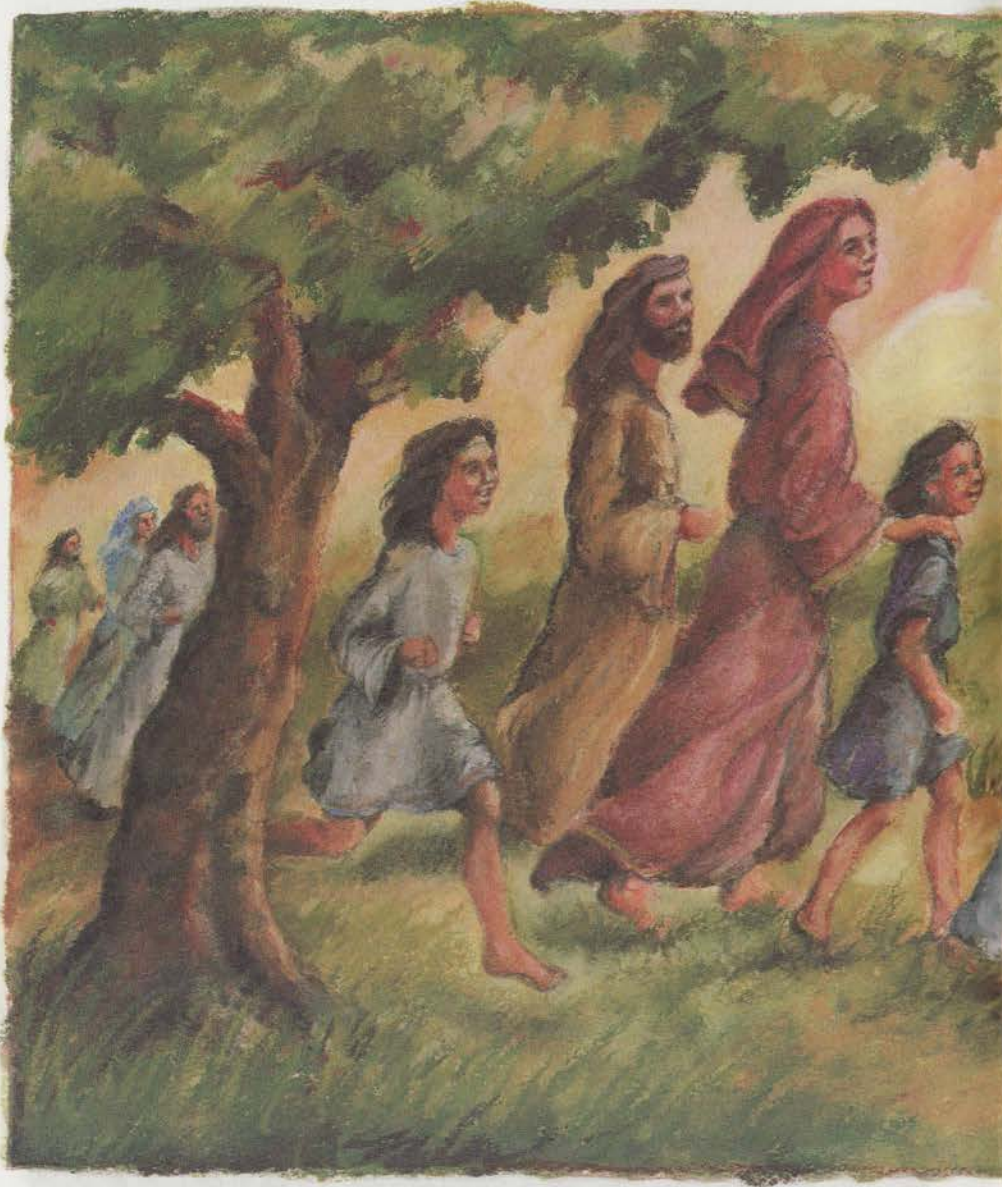




Long ago in Bethlehem, a little  
boy was born.



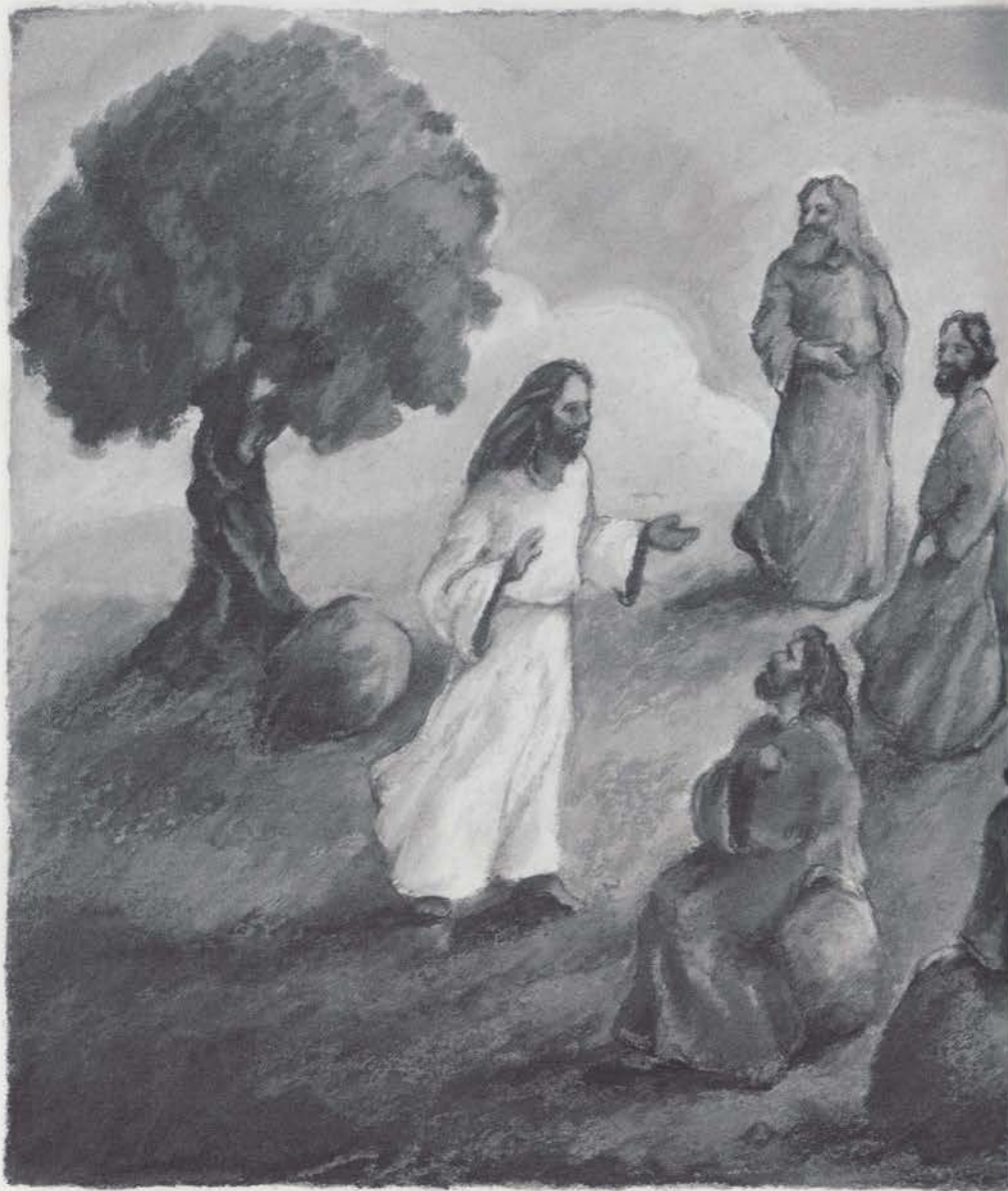
His mother whispered, "Jesus,"  
on that first Christmas morn.



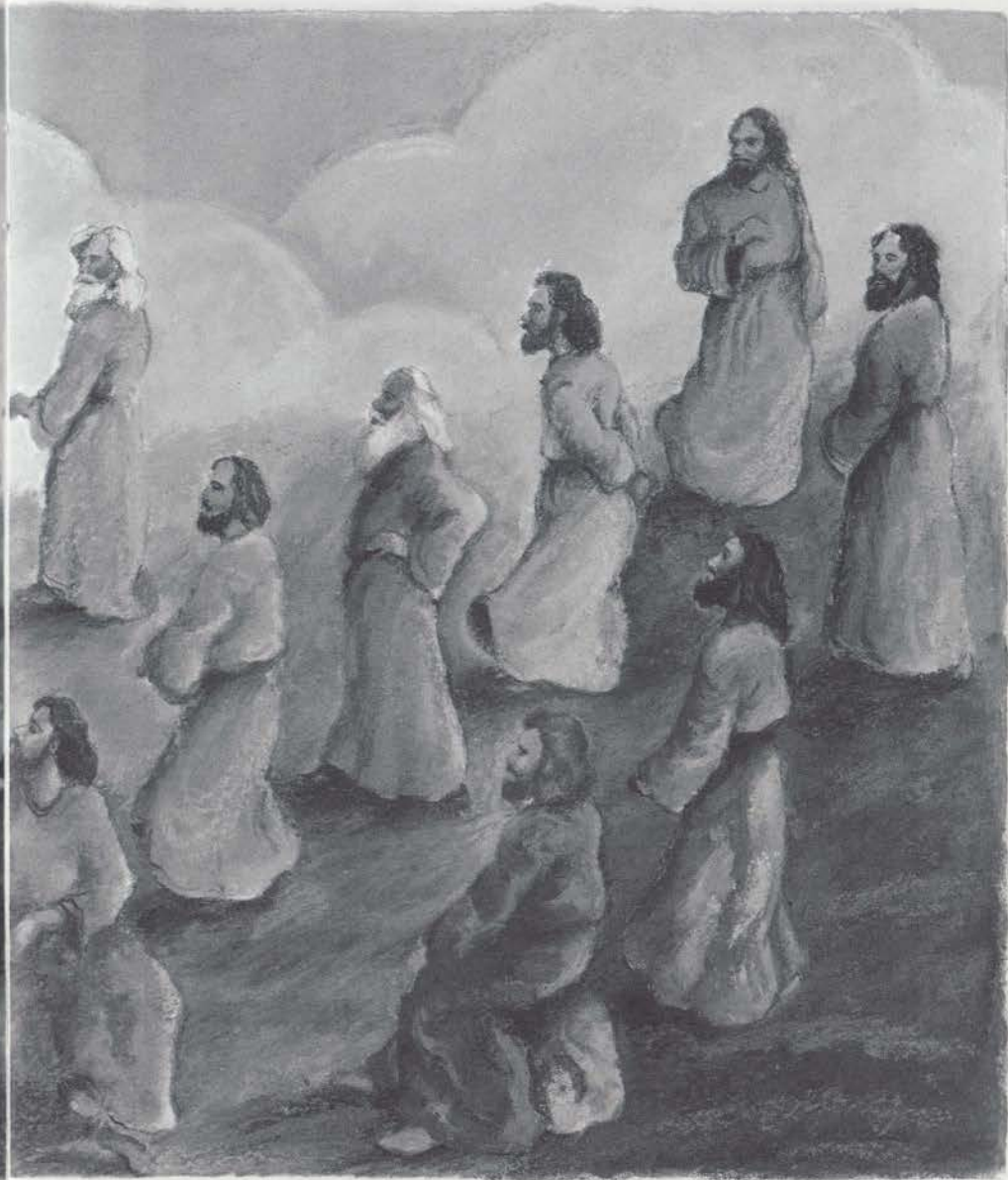
The boy Jesus grew to be a man,  
and he was wise and strong.



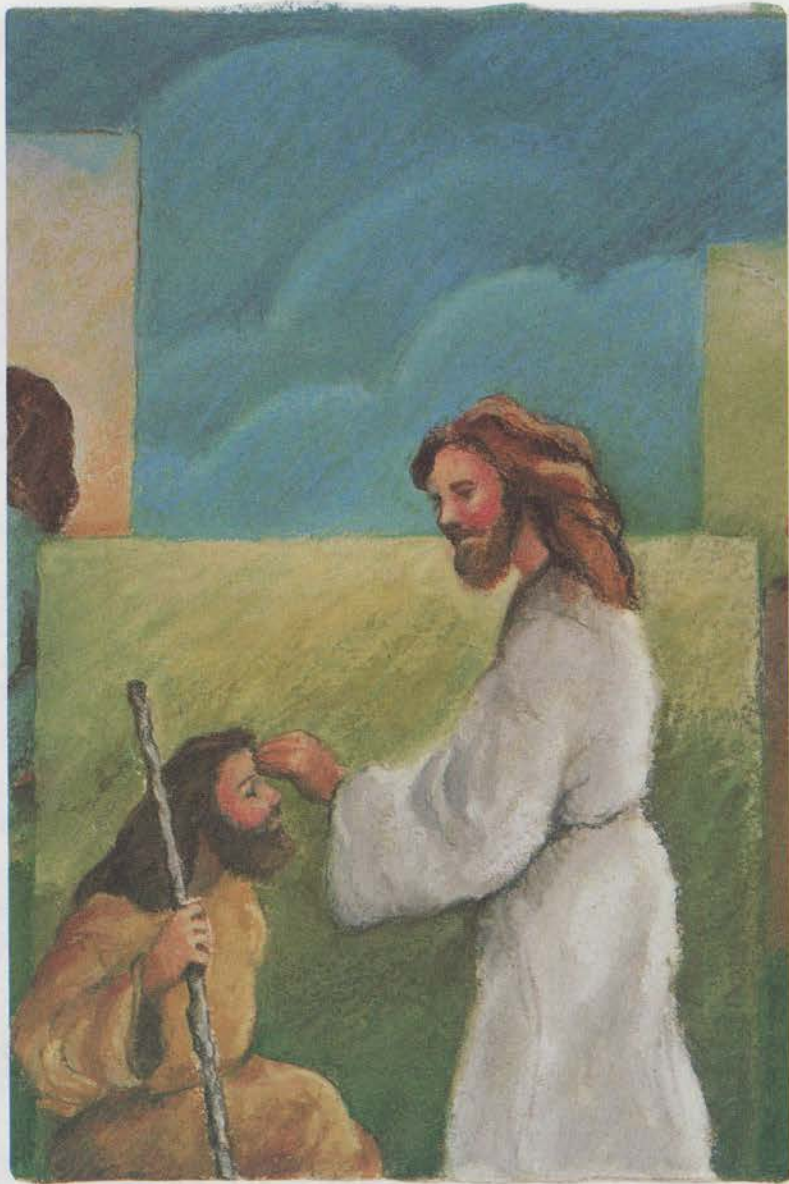
People followed after him  
as he walked along.



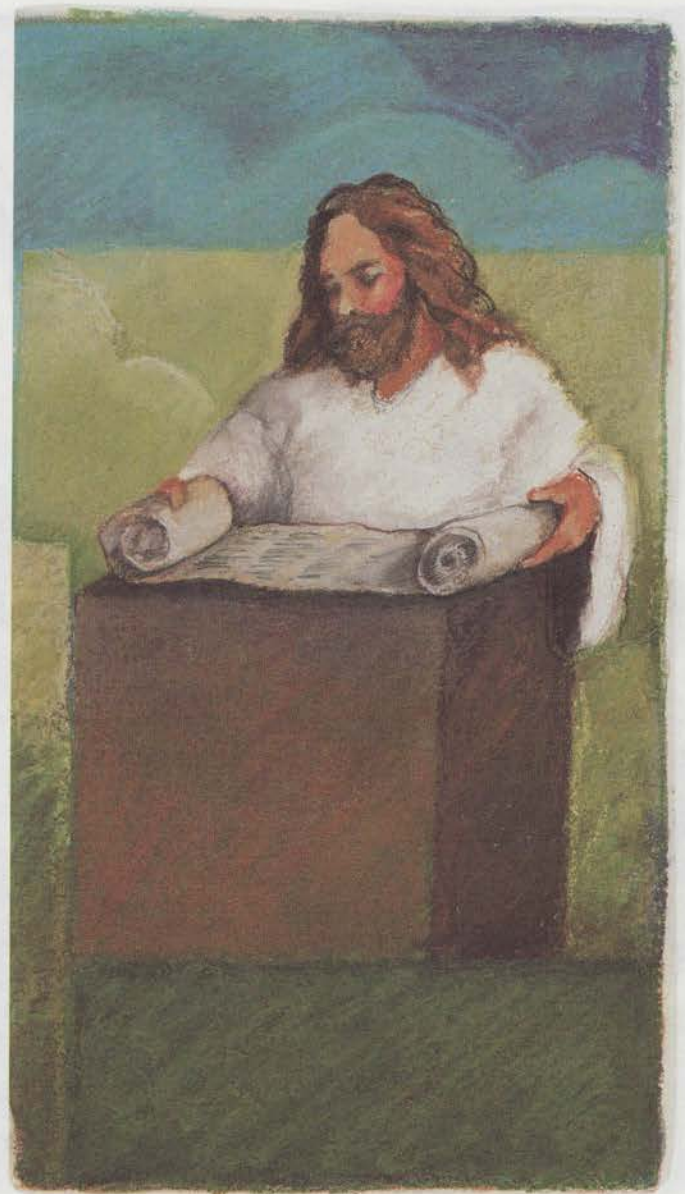
Then Jesus chose disciples,

were some who heard the call.



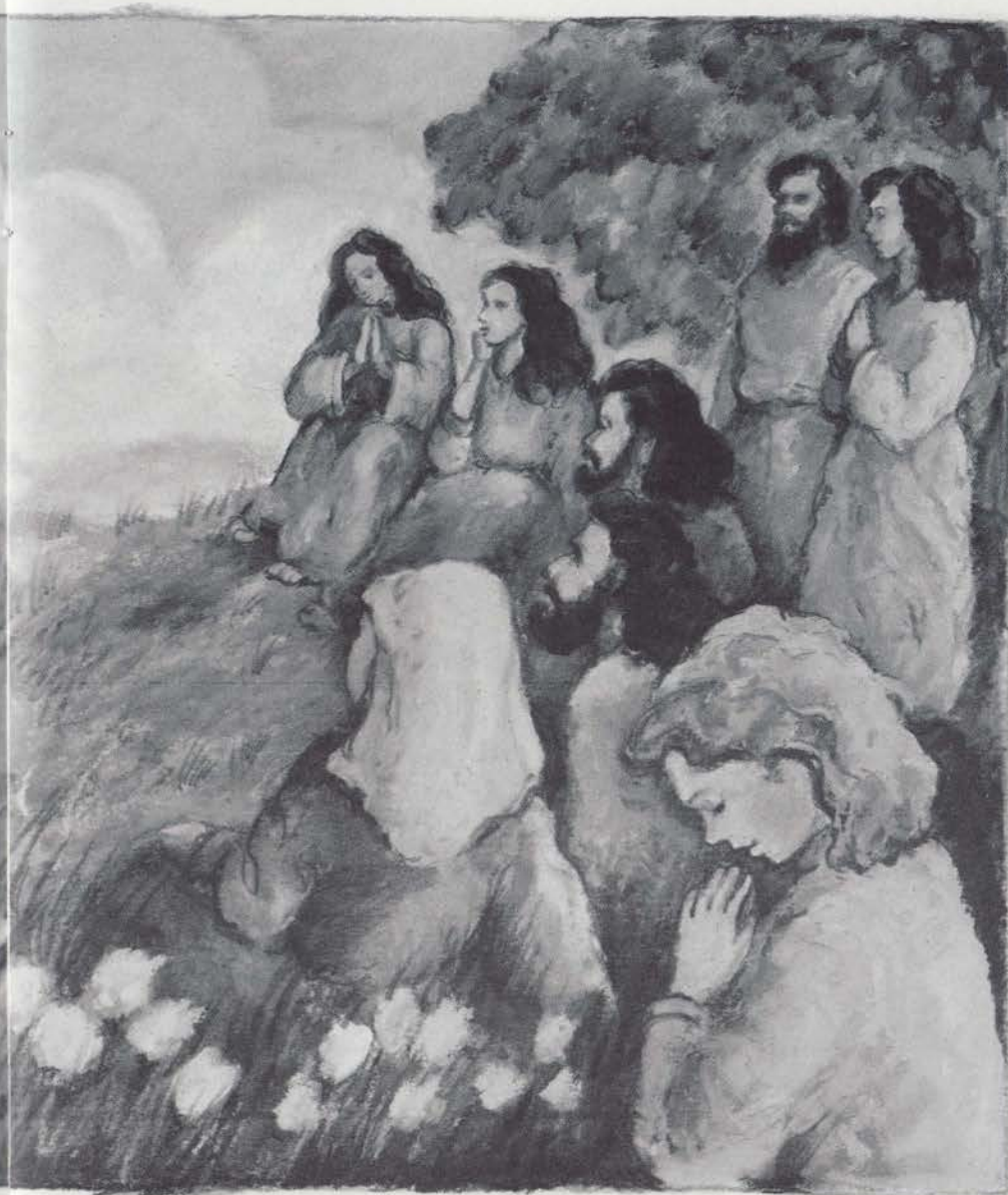
Jesus was a teacher, a preacher,  
and a healer, too.



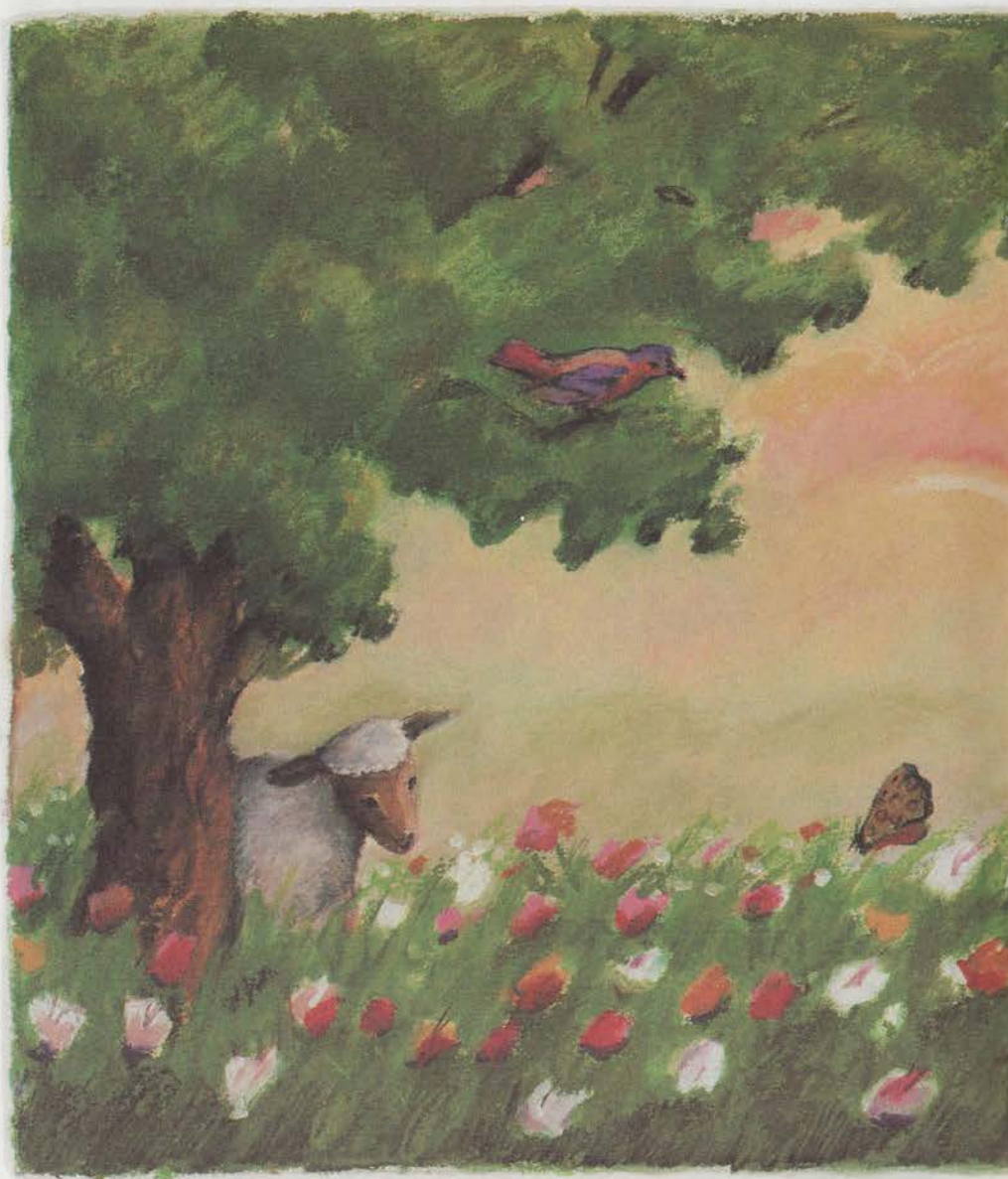
He taught us how to live and  
what we ought to do.



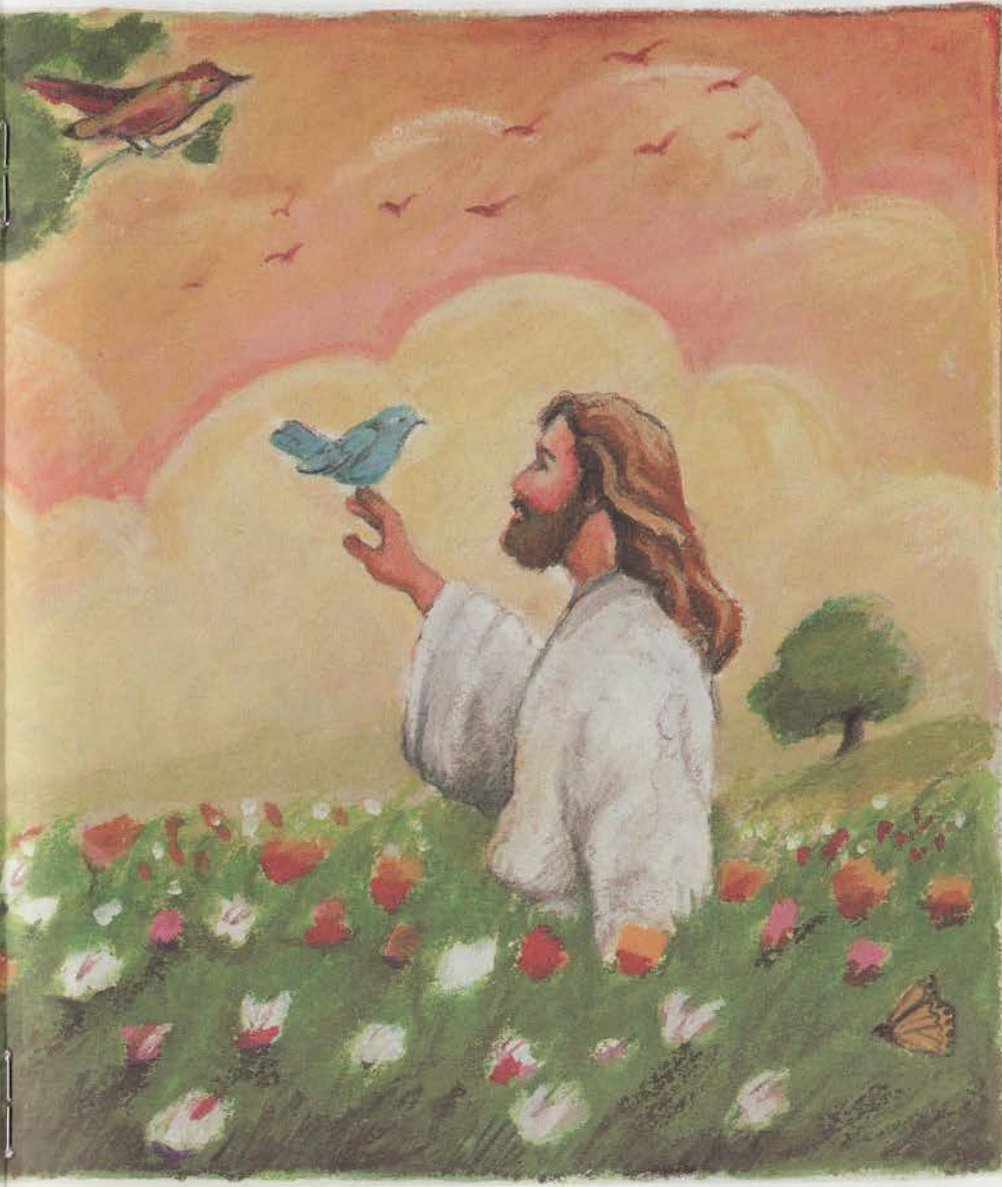
The people listened carefully  
to all he had to say.



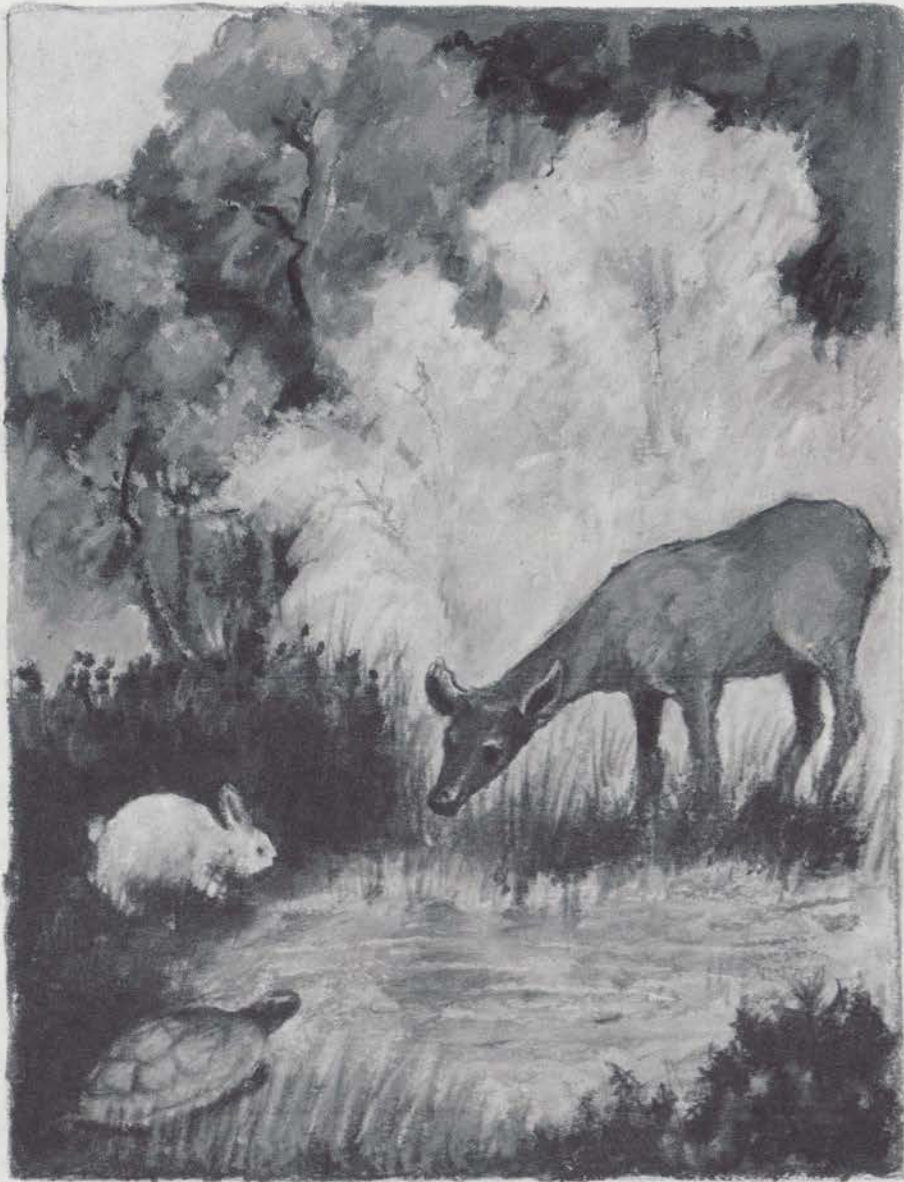
He said, "God

about what to eat and wear.



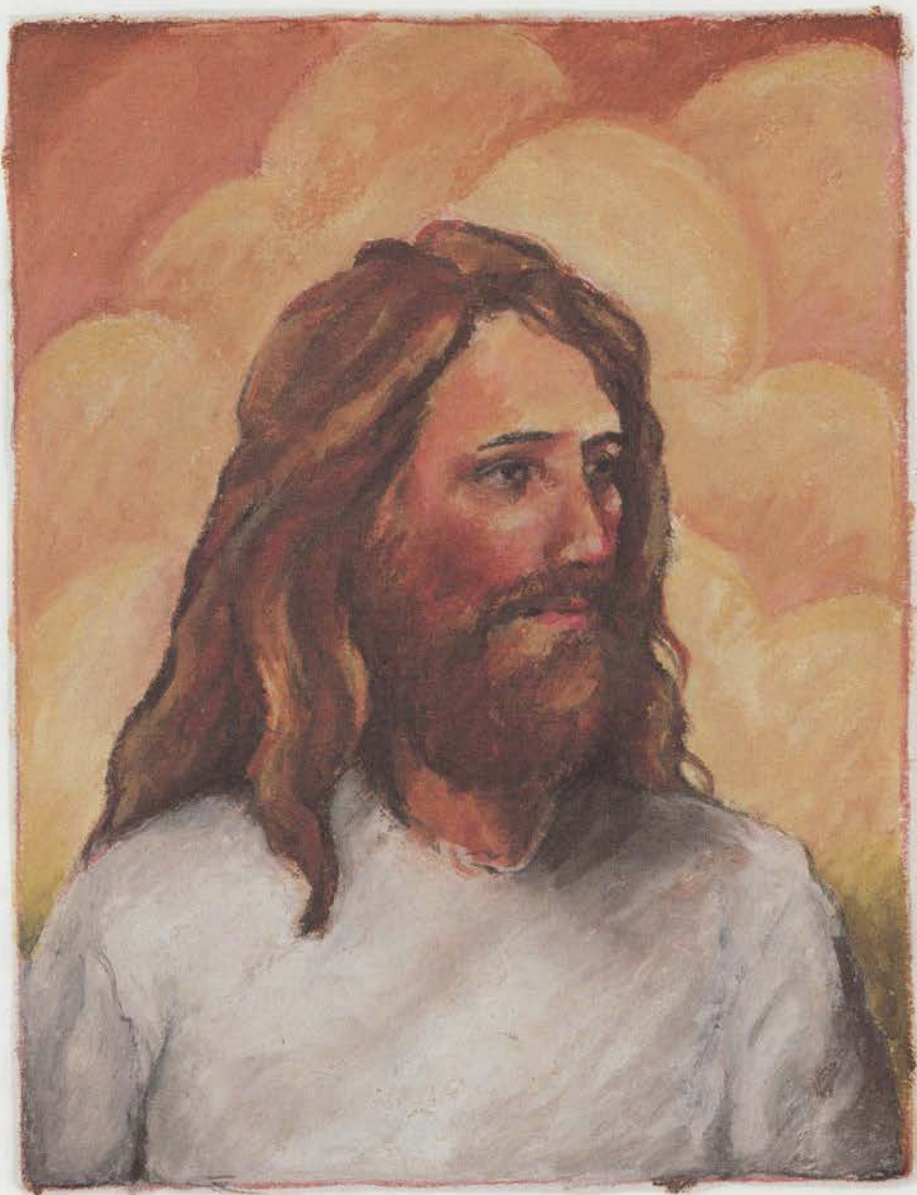
He said that we should trust in God  
like sparrows in the air.



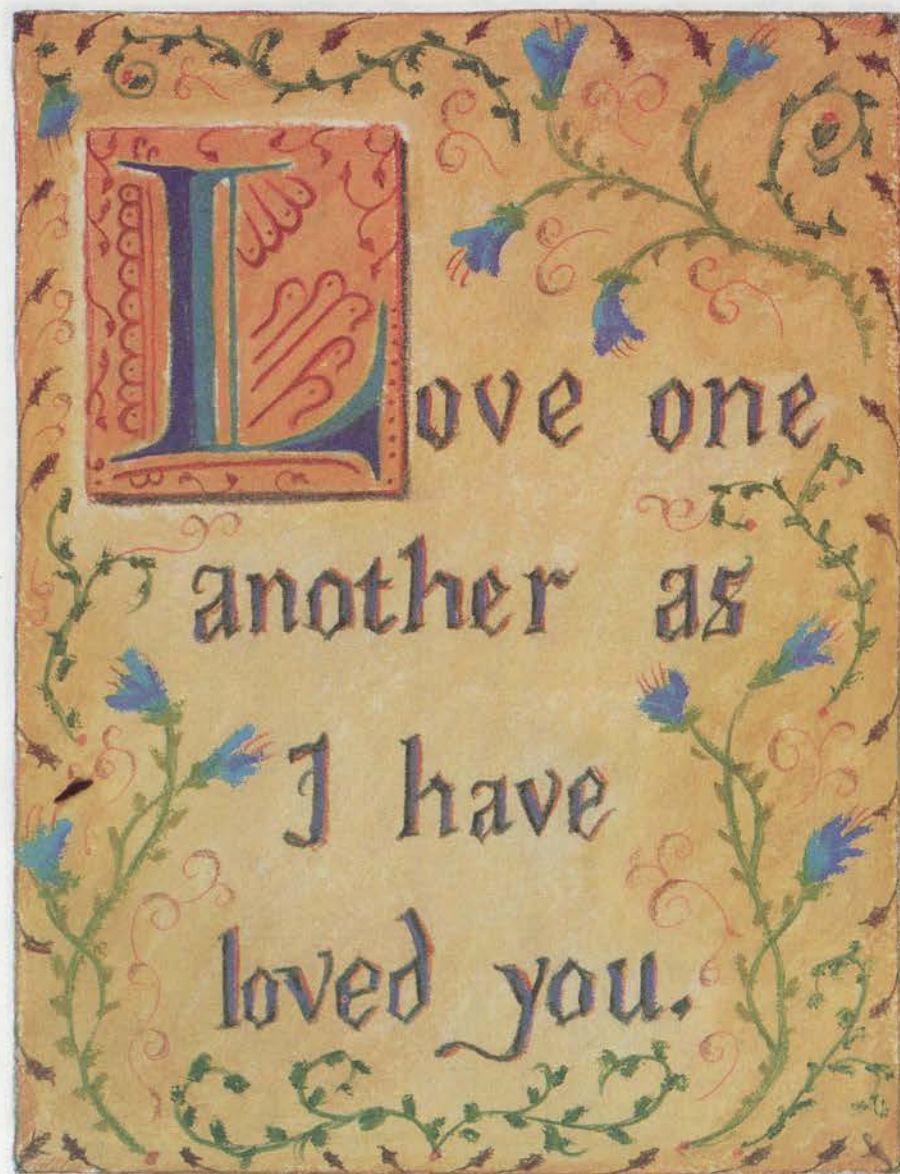
Jesus said that God in heaven

as Jesus loves us still,



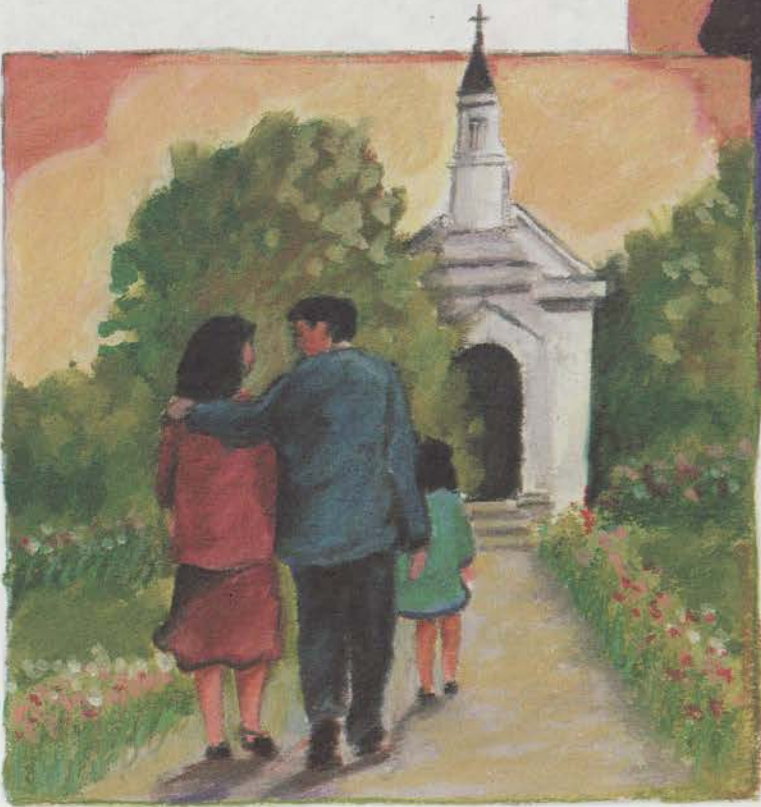
And pray for those who hurt us,  
is to do God's will.



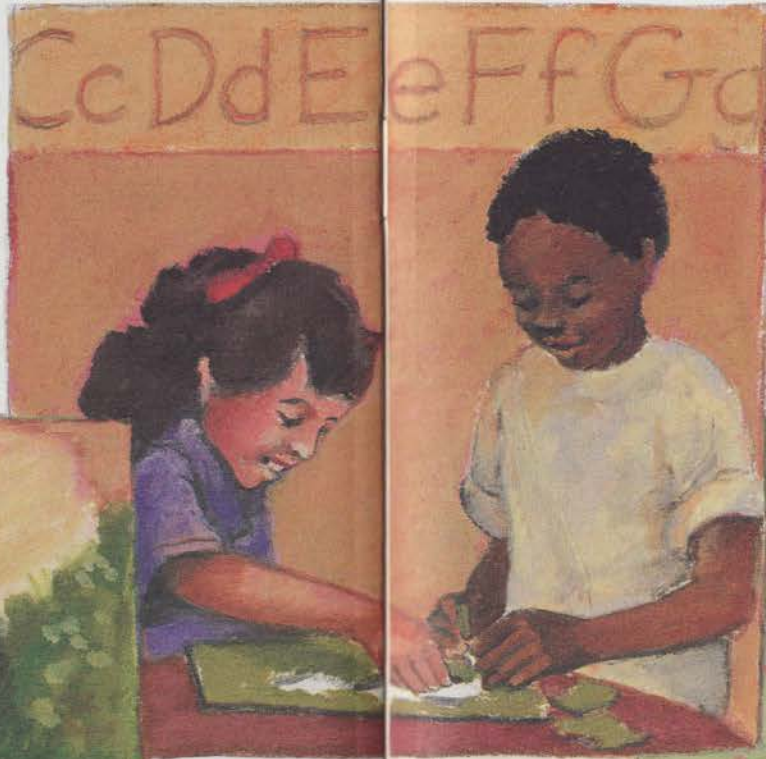
Our neighbors are the people

to care for one another,



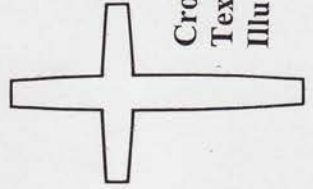
Friends at church,
