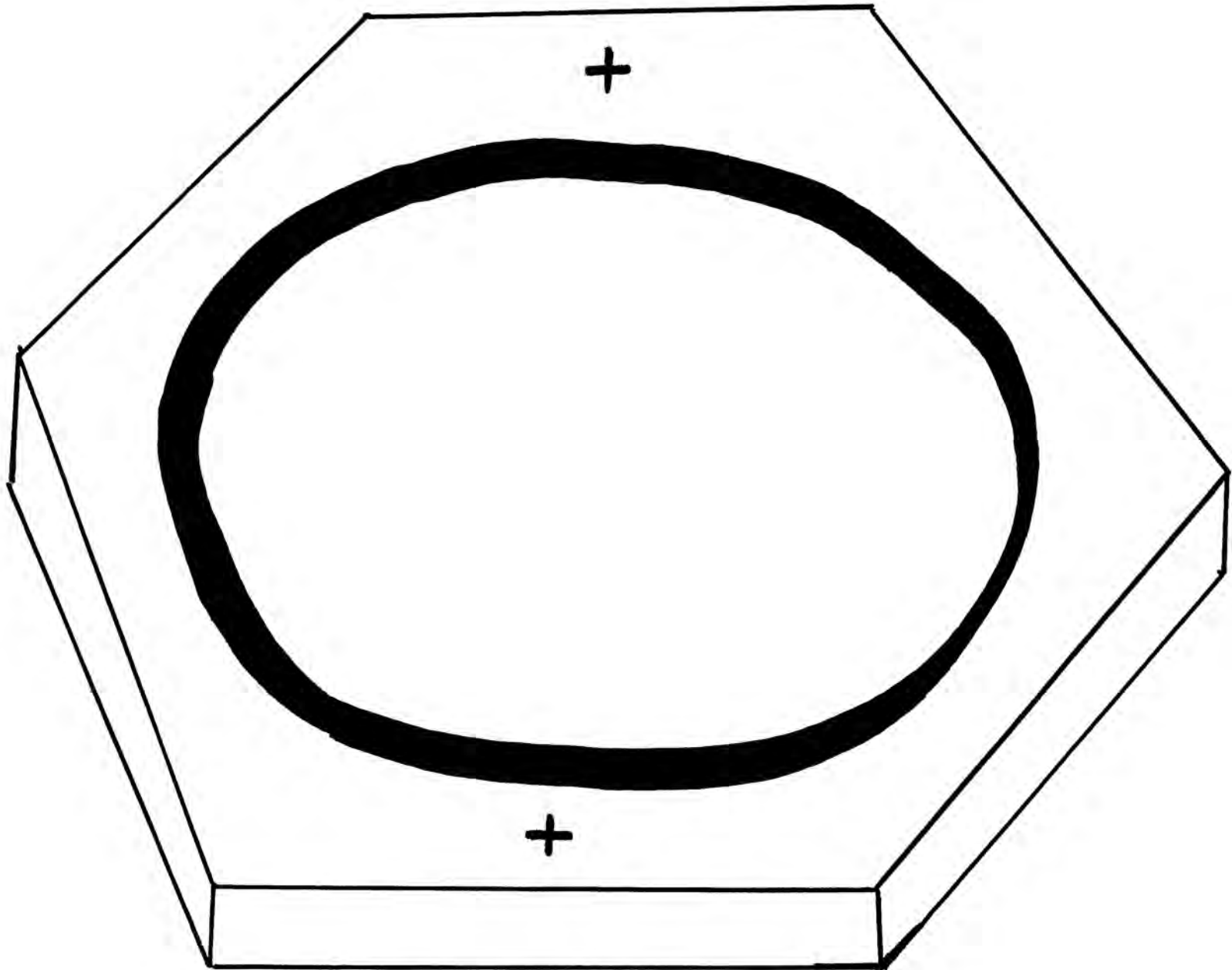
Episcopal Shield III.1

SALT DOUGH RECIPE

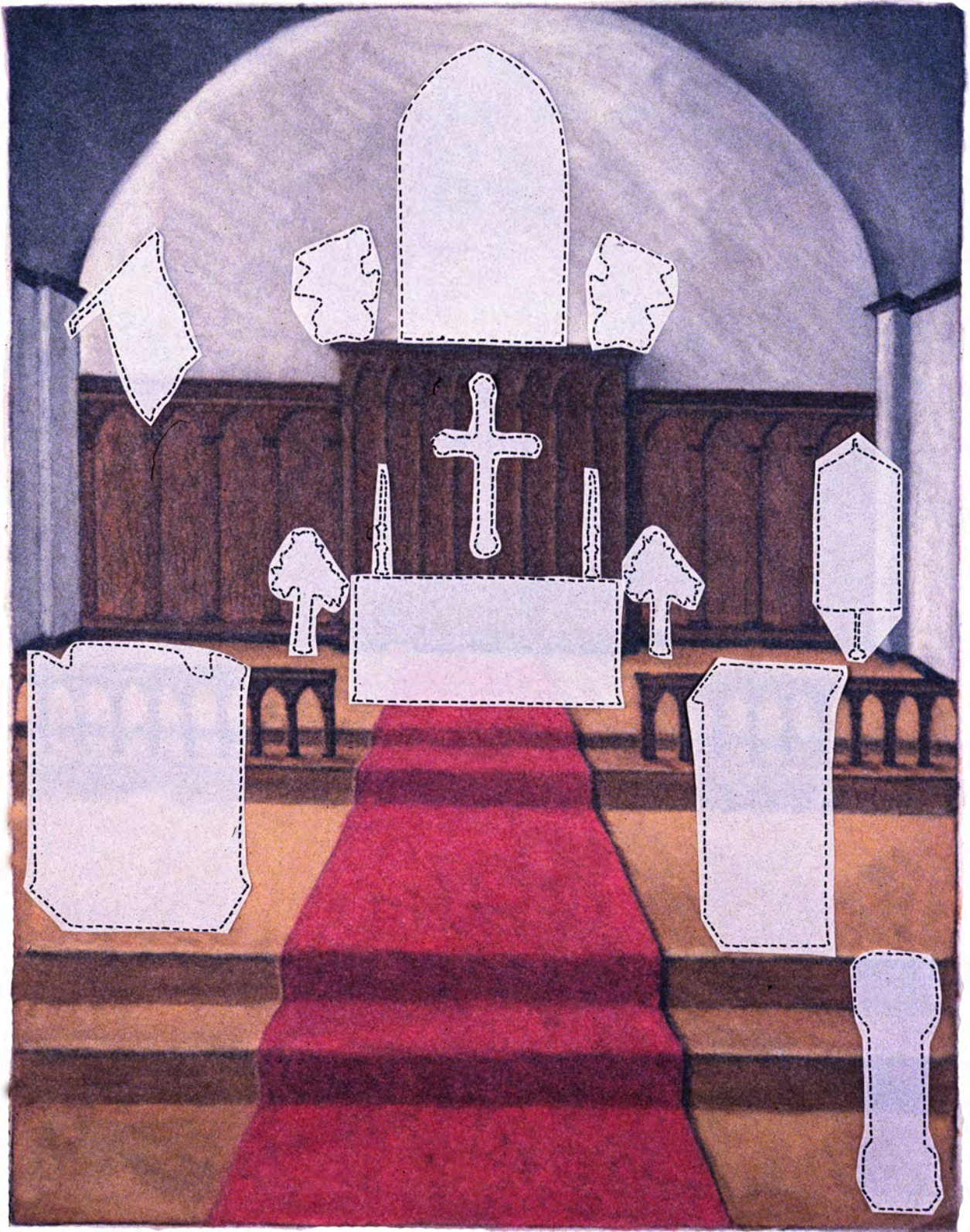
1 cup salt
2 cups flour
1 cup water

Mix salt and flour together. Gradually add water. Knead until dough is smooth and pliable. Form into shapes desired.

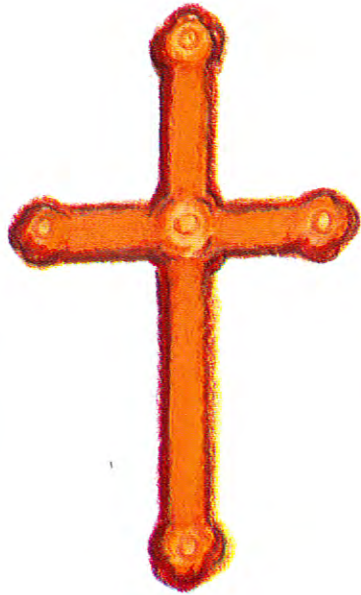
Bake at 325 degrees (or let air dry for 48 hours).
When cool varnish or paint.

PLAY DOUGH

3 cups water

3 cups flour

1 1/2 cups salt

6 tablespoons oil

6 teaspoons Cream of Tarter

Food Coloring

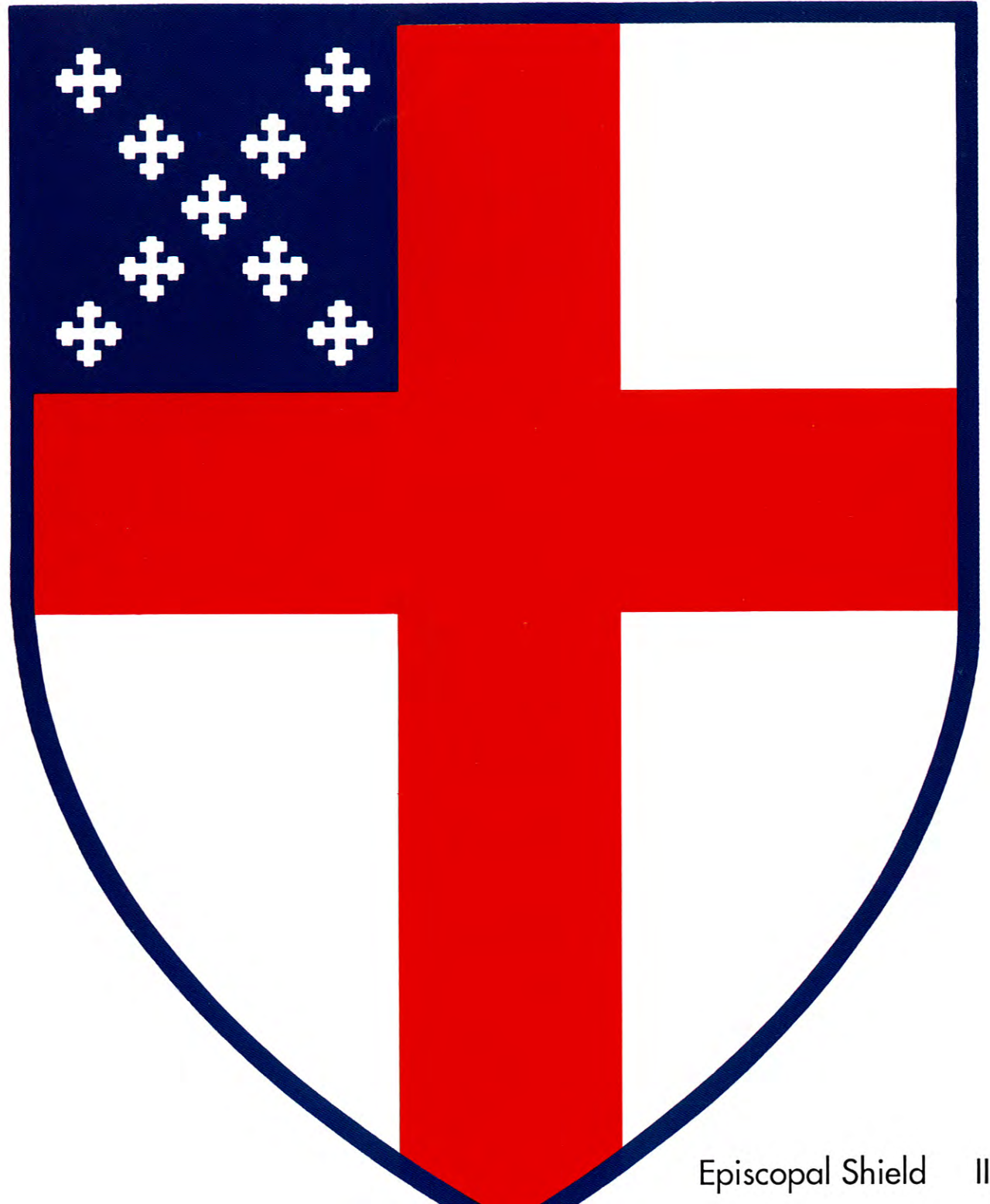
Use an electric skillet or large saucepan. Mix well before the heat is turned on. Cook and stir over low heat until mixture sticks together in a ball and the color has dulled somewhat. Cool. Knead well. Stored in an air-tight container, play dough will keep for months.
