## Items NOT to Bring:

- ⊗ Incense \*
- ⊗ Candles \*
- ⊗ Nails, screws, thumbtacks (3M Command strips and hooks are acceptable)
- ⊗ Pets (including fish) (Residence Hall only)
- ⊗ Refrigerator, microwave, small electric kitchen appliances (only coffeemakers or electric kettles with automatic shut off are permitted in a residence hall unit).
- ⊗ Any weapons

\*In lieu of candles or incense, you may want to consider getting an essential oil diffuser.
